

BRUSSELS

Brussels is a strategic city in Europe due to its many government offices. It is the unofficial capital of the European Union and home to the European Parliament. It is also the headquarters of NATO and has major branch offices of the United Nations, UNESCO, World Health Organization, World Bank, and others. Because Brussels is home to so many European and international government agencies, it is a crucial city and needs a strong testimony for the Lord.

Last year in 2019, as the church in Brussels was having a prayer meeting, we realized that at that moment all the European heads of state were meeting in Brussels for a crucial vote regarding Brexit. The saints grasped the opportunity to beseech the Lord as the Ruler of the kings of the earth to govern their decisions according to His desire in His economy. **Because Europe will be used by the Antichrist at the end of the age, having a strong testimony in Brussels is crucial for the Lord's move to consummate His economy for His return.**

The church life began in Brussels in the year 2000 when a young sister from Armenia migrated to Brussels. She had been saved and baptized in Armenia through the work in Russia. She began to share the ministry with others, and they began to have the Lord's table in 2001. They also began to blend with the other saints in Europe, and the first conference in Brussels was held in 2002. The Lord gradually added saints into the church life, and currently there are about 55 active saints in the church in Brussels.

Approximately two-thirds of the saints practice the church life in French and one-third in English. The saints in Brussels represent at least 15 different nationalities and many different languages. Most of the saints practice the church life in a language other than their mother tongue.

The saints who meet as the church in Brussels live in a wide geographical area, stretching from the Dutch border in the north to the area of Lille (north of France) in the west. The many backgrounds of the saints provide a rich opportunity for the expression of the one new man.

Brussels is centrally located within Western Europe and is in the center of the country of Belgium, which borders Holland to the north and east, France to the south, and the English Channel to the west. Belgium has a population of approximately 11 million people. The Brussels metropolitan area has a population of approximately 2.1 million people.

There are over 12 universities in Brussels and 86,000 students. The universities have programs taught in both Flemish (Dutch) and French, which are the two major official languages in Belgium. Many programs are taught in English as well. Because of its international makeup, Brussels is a very popular city to study.
