1) 2021 Fall University Conference (19-21 November)

The 2021 fall conference for European university students will take place in the UK on 19-21 November. The subject will be “Acts—the Continuation of Christ.” Additional details can be found at <https://unistudents.eu/>. Please pray:

- That the Lord will release many students from all over Europe to register and attend.
- For the travel and health of all those who attend, before, during, and after the conference.
- That all the attendants will receive and have a renewed vision of God's eternal economy (Acts 9:4-5; 26:19) to be the Lord's witnesses (Acts 1:8) and the Lord's continuation on the campuses in Europe (Acts 1:14, 2:42, 28:31), and will take no way except the way of prayer, the Spirit, and the Word (Acts 4:31).
