

## **Burdens related to Europe (week of 9 January 2022)**

### **1) Online Baltic-Nordic conference (25-28 January 2022)**

The upcoming Online Baltic-Nordic Conference will be hosted by the churches in the Baltic States (Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania). Five selected messages from the December 2021 semiannual training on 1 and 2 Samuel will be ministered. ### **2) Church in Rostov-on-Don Meeting Hall**

The church in Rostov-on-Don, established in 1994, is seeking to purchase a meeting hall. Today the church has approximately 90 saints. The brothers there have found a suitable meeting facility at a cost of a little over 400,000 USD. The amount needed to complete the purchase with renovations is 200,000 USD. The first installment of 30% will be paid on January 10, and the remaining amount is due by May 1.
