1) Central and Eastern European and Baltic (CEEb) Conference in Bucharest, Romania (23-25 September)

2) First Lord's table and mini-conference in Lisbon, Portugal (1-2 October)

5) The conflict in Ukraine

Please continue to pray that:

- The Lord will continue to use the fourth cycle of the gospel and shepherding trips, from 8-25 September, to care for the Ukrainian refugees in Poland in Warsaw, Krakow, and Wrocław (Vroh-tswaf)
- The local saints, serving ones, and trainees will be blended with the Ukrainian refugees for the strengthening and building up of the Lord's testimony in key European cities
- The saints in Russia and Ukraine will be kept in the oneness of the Body and the reality of the new man
- The tripartite being of the saints in the besieged cities will be protected and preserved for the Lord's interests

From the footnote on 1 Kings 8:48: "...no matter for whom we are praying, our prayers should be aimed at the interests of God, i.e., at Christ and the church as God's interests on earth, for the fulfilling of God's economy."
