Report on the Lord's Move in Iceland — June 2025

Dear Saints,

In our recent trip to Iceland we had a group of 13 saints, 7 of which were a mix of full-timers and community saints, and 6 of which were University students (5 from London and 1 from Warsaw). Our burden at the start of the trip was to take care of some of our uni students in London and also to continue our regular visitations to the saints that are in Iceland. We were blessed with wonderful weather for the majority of our time there, and we all had a wonderful time blending together with one another as well as with the saints.

Since we had a younger group this time, the feeling was to cherish the students and not focus so much on doing a "work." We spent most mornings fellowshipping and reading from a book called *A Young Man in God's Plan* and spending quiet and personal time with the Lord. This time was very profitable.

Every evening, except for one, we all worked together to prepare a meal in order to invite the saints after they had a long day at work. Our times were filled with fellowship and enjoyment of the Lord through singing and praising.

On Saturday we managed to set up a table in the city centre, and we distributed 25 New Testament Recovery Versions, passed out many gospel tracts, and had a number of divine conversations with the tourists and locals in Iceland. We met a second-year local uni student; Ilanita, who is half Russian and half Icelandic. Ilanita speaks Russian, English, and Icelandic and was instantly drawn to us. She spent that evening and most of the Lord's Day with us, helping to cook, fellowshipping with the sisters, and enjoying the Lord together. On that same afternoon we met 2 marines from the French navy. They also joined us for dinner that night, and one of them also joined us for dinner the following evening. All 3 of these contacts have been inscribed in our hearts, and we are seeking the Lord on how to shepherd these ones.

On Lord's Day morning we gathered together with the saints in Iceland and had a very enjoyable time praising the Lord together. We then split up into language groups for separate fellowship times. All the saints were exercised and released through singing and praising.

Since most of us were flying back home Monday in the early morning, we ended our time with a Ukrainian feast that the saints prepared for us on Lord's Day evening. A few of the contacts we had met in past visits were also invited to the feast, and we were able to catch up as well as introduce new faces.

Please continue to pray for the saints in Iceland, that the Lord will continue to make home in their hearts and that their inner man will be renewed day by day. Pray also that the Lord will preserve every member of each of the families for Himself and that they will not be swept away by the tide of this evil age.

Please also pray for our new contact Ilanita. Pray that the Lord will burden her to pursue Him fervently and that she will pick up a burden for her friends and neighbors. Pray also that the Lord can make use of her knowledge of the languages she's fluent in so that she can be a bridge between the saints and the local Icelanders, as Russian and Ukrainian are still the primary languages they speak.

May the Lord continue the work He has started in Iceland!
